Australia's most loved island resort to relaunch better than ever

There will soon be a new holiday destination to add to your bucket list with the reopening of Daydream Island Resort in early 2019. Following an extensive \$100 million redevelopment, the new premium resort will become a tropical haven for romantics, families and groups.

The now 4.5* resort will offer 277 refurbished modern rooms and suites with the choice of interconnecting rooms for families and special access rooms.

There will be an expanded food and beverage offering across the island with three restaurants; Graze Interactive Dining, Infinity and Inkstone Kitchen and Bar and three bars; Barefoot Bar, Tonic and Silica. Guests will be able to dive into a snorkeling adventure at any time of the day or explore the island & surrounding Great Barrier Reef Marine Park by helicopter, sailboat or jetski. Daydream Island Resort will have activities for all ages with swimming pools, coral beaches, gym facilities and unlimited access to non-motorised water activities. The Kid's Club will be a haven for children with an exciting range of activities on offer each day and the exclusive adult's only area will cater to those in search of a sanctuary.

The island will offer a revitalised pool landscape allowing guests to swim and enjoy unparalleled views across the Whitsunday's Great Barrier Reef. The swimming hub will be complemented by a poolside bar inclusive of a new burger concept.

The Living Reef, will also be making its return to the island in an even bigger and better capacity than before, further developing its education and eco-friendly focus. The free form coral lagoon will wrap 200m around the central building being and hold over 1.5 million litres of water. Guests will be able to join the team of marine biologists who live on the island and feed baby stingrays who live amongst over 100 species of marine fish, coral and invertebrates such as starfish, sea cucumbers and crabs.

Daydream Island Resort's event space will cater major events, yet still provide a personal touch. Guests visiting the island for conferences will have access to the latest technology audio visual equipment across three dedicated conference rooms. Special events from cocktail parties to gala dinners can be catered for across a large range of indoor and outdoor event locations, with weddings continuing to play a part in the story of Daydream Island Resort.
